YES on VOTE BY MAIL



Too many eligible voters are left out of our elections because of Connecticut's outdated requirement that voters provide an excuse to vote by mail.

It's time we amend our constitution to allow no-excuse absentee voting. You can make that happen when you vote for the constitutional resolution.

**Early voting period: October 21 to November 3
from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.**

Election Day: November 5



YES on Vote by Mail means:

- Any voter can request and cast an absentee (mail-in) ballot — no excuse or reason necessary.

But WHY?

- ✓ 36 states and the District of Columbia already allow no-excuse absentee voting.
 - Connecticut and New Hampshire are the only states in New England that do not allow no-excuse absentee voting.
- ✓ Our elections will be more accessible, especially for disabled voters, elderly voters, voters with caretaking responsibilities, and voters without reliable transportation
- ✓ More people will participate in our elections.
 - In 2022, states with no-excuse absentee voting saw **8% higher turnout** than states that require an excuse to vote by mail.
- ✓ Voting by mail has no impact on partisan turnout — neither political party will benefit over the other.
