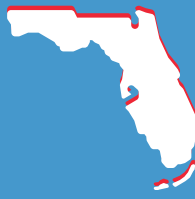


How to Fill Out a Florida Voter Registration Application



Write very clearly. Only use blue or black pen.

Lines 1-6 and Line 15 MUST be completed.

You MUST sign and date the form.

Lines 1, 2 and 3: These checkboxes ask you to confirm your eligibility to vote. DO NOT check the box or continue filling out the form if you are unsure of your answer.

Line 4: Date of Birth and ID Number (FL Driver License/ID Card or last 4 of Social Security #).

If you don't have a Florida Driver License or a State of Florida ID Card, you can use the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number. You can still register to vote without any of these numbers, but you will have to provide additional identifying information. Check the box for "I have never been issued a FL DL/ID or SSN" and election officials will contact you with next steps. We recommend including a phone number on Line 10.

Line 6: Provide the residential street address for the physical place where you live (no P.O. boxes).

For example, students who live on campus should put the street address for their dorm room. If you receive mail at a different address from where you live, your mailing address can be put on Line 7.

*If you are unhoused or live in a non-traditional residence, you can still register to vote!
Call your county elections office to ask what address to use on Line 6. If the office is closed, enter the address where you typically receive messages (if mail is received there).
Include your phone number on Line 10 so the elections office can contact you.*

Line 10: You are not required to provide your phone or email, but we recommend including.

Doing so will let elections officials contact you easily if there are questions about your application.

Line 11: If you do not select a party you will be registered as "No Party Affiliation" or "NPA."

If you are registered as NPA you will not be able to vote in party primary elections.

Line 15: SIGN and DATE the form!

This signature will be used to match with the one on your vote-by-mail ballot envelope, so sign the way you normally do or will easily remember. Voters with disabilities can use a stamp if that is their legal signature.
