

REMEDIES AVAILABLE TO PERSONS DENIED ACCESS TO RECORDS

If you have been denied access to the records of the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission, the following remedies are available to you:

1. You may, in writing, request a formal hearing before the full Commission on the matter.
2. You may file an action for a Writ of Mandamus in the District Court of Lancaster County.
3. You may petition the Nebraska Attorney General to review the records to determine whether they may be withheld from public inspection. This determination must be made by the Attorney General within 15 days after the

submission of the petition. If the Attorney General determines that the records may not be withheld, the public body shall be ordered to disclose the records immediately.

4. If the public body continues to withhold the records, you may:
 - a) Bring suit in the District Court of Lancaster County; or
 - b) Demand in writing that the Attorney General bring suit in the name of the State in the District Court of Lancaster County. You have a right to intervene as a full party in the suit at any time.

In any case in which an individual seeking access to records has substantially prevailed, the court may assess reasonable attorneys fees and other litigation costs reasonably incurred by the individual against the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission. The foregoing is based upon the provisions of §84-712 et seq. of the Nebraska Statutes.
