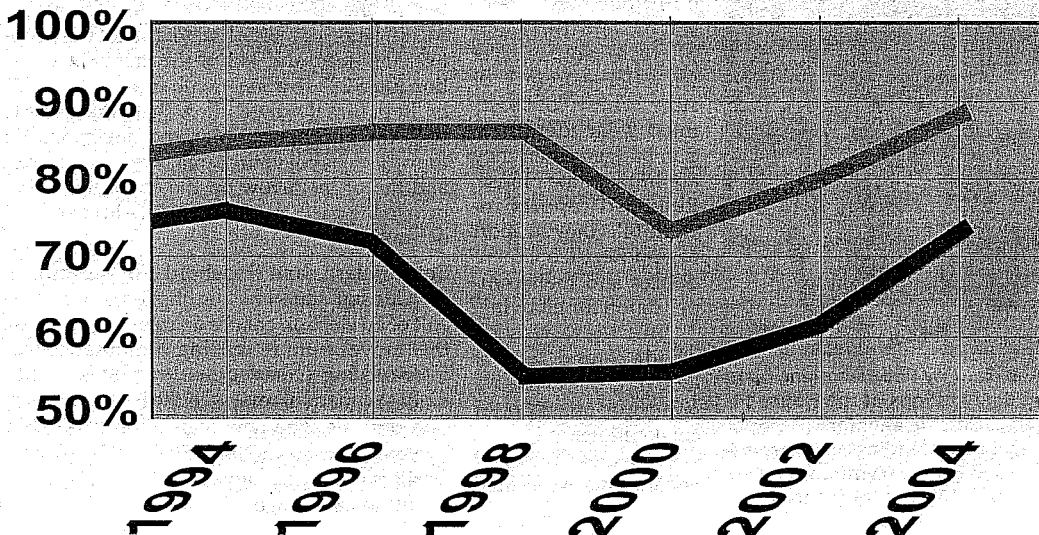

**VOTES** are compiled as "Pro" or "Anti" Common Cause on the basis of whether the representative or senator supported or opposed the reform Common Cause had urged. 34 Senate votes and 31 House votes are counted in this 2-year scorecard. Votes in subject columns are calculated as "Pro-CC" divided by total possible in that area (i.e. 3 pro-ethics votes out of 4 possible gives 75%.
