


Redistricting Rules: Alabama Timeline







Who draws the lines?

By statute, the legislature draws congressional and state legislative lines, which are subject to gubernatorial veto

Women Voters

- Federal equal population requirements and adherence to the Voting Rights Act and constitutional rules on race
- State Senate districts must be "as nearly equal to each other in the number of inhabitants as may be" (Ala. Const. art. IX, § 200)
- State legislative districts must be contiguous and follow county lines, except where they would not comply with other legal requirements (Ala. Const. art. IX, § 200)
- In 2011, the legislature adopted additional guidelines for redistricting, but it is unclear if they will adopt them again.
