


Redistricting Rules: Arizona Timeline



At least 5 months:

Public hearings to take communities of interest testimony

Approx. 4 months:

Process census data, display draft maps, hold hearings, complete maps Court & County Prep





Who draws the lines?

Congressional and state legislative lines are drawn by an independent redistricting commission

- Federal equal population requirements and adherence to the Voting Rights Act and constitutional rules on race
- Maps must begin with a "grid-like pattern" which must then be contiguous, compact, and respect communities of interest (Ariz. Const. Art. IV, pt. 2, § 1(14))
- Nesting: two AZ House districts are nested in one AZ Senate district (Ariz. Const. art. IV, pt. 2, § 1(1))
- As possible, should use geographic features, existing jurisdictional boundaries, and undivided census tracts (Ariz. Const. Art. IV, pt. 2, § 1(14))
- Favor competitive districts (Ariz. Const. Art. IV, pt. 2, § 1(14))
