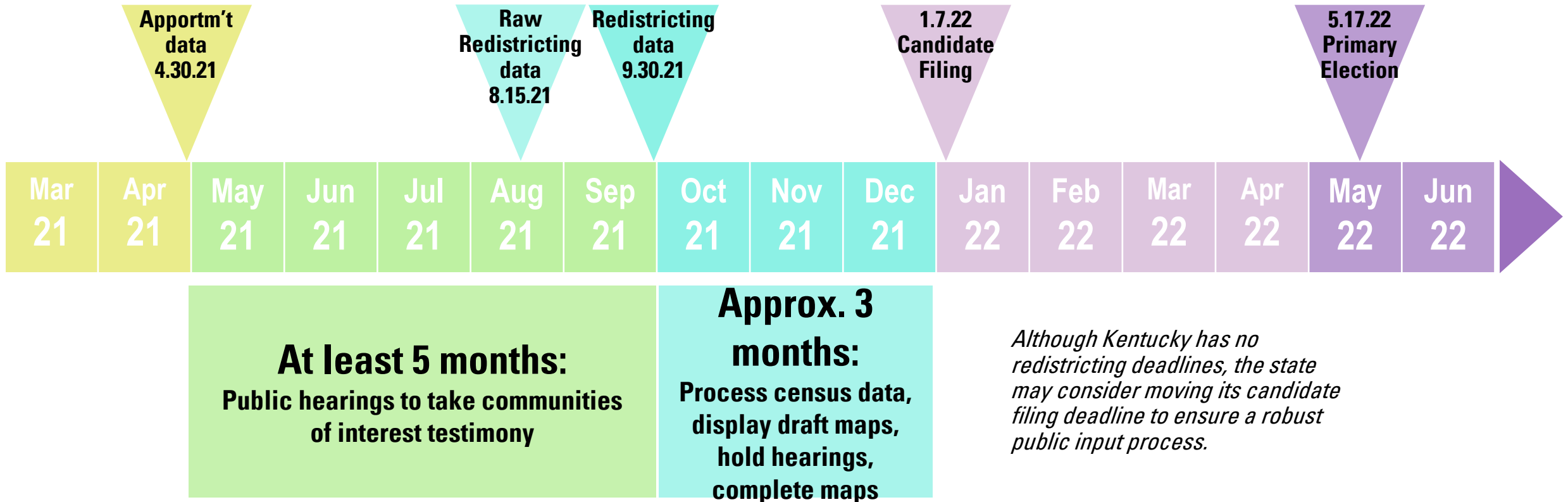
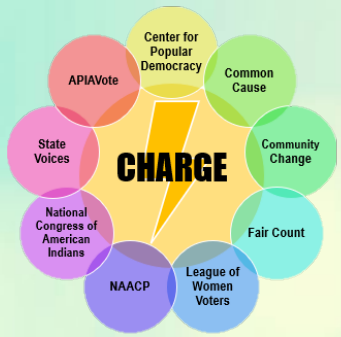

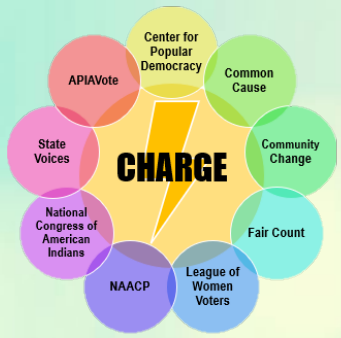




Redistricting Rules: Kentucky Rules

Who draws the lines?

- ▶ Congressional and state legislative lines are **drawn by the state legislature** and subject to a gubernatorial vote



Redistricting Rules: Kentucky Rules

What are the mapping rules?

- ▶ Federal **equal population** requirements
- ▶ State legislative districts be as nearly equal in population as may be without dividing a county (Ky. Const. § 33)
- ▶ Adherence to the **Voting Rights Act** and constitutional rules on race
- ▶ Districts be contiguous and preserve whole counties when possible (Ky. Const. § 33)
