


Redistricting Rules: Minnesota Timeline



At least 5 months:

Public hearings to take communities of interest testimony

4 months:

Process census data, display draft maps, hold hearings, complete maps Court & County Process

> Created by Common Cause Holding Power Accountable



Redistricting Rules: Minnesota Rules

Who draws the lines?

Congressional and state legislative lines are drawn by the state legislature and subject to a gubernatorial vote

What are the mapping rules?

- Federal equal population requirements and adherence to the Voting Rights Act and constitutional rules on race
- **Contiguity:** for congressional lines, MN Senate, MN House
- **Nesting**: MN House districts must be nested within MN Senate districts
- The legislature has extended the contiguity requirement to all congressional and legislative districts, and asked that political subdivisions not be divided more than necessary
