




## **Redistricting Rules:** North Carolina

## Who draws the lines?

- Congressional lines are drawn by the state legislature, and are not subject to a gubernatorial veto
- State legislative lines are drawn by the state legislature, and are not subject to a gubernatorial veto





## What are the mapping rules?

- Federal equal population requirements and adherence to the Voting Rights Act and constitutional rules on race
- State legislative districts must be as equal in population as possible (N.C. Const. Art. II, §§ 3(1), 5(1))
- State legislative districts must be contiguous and district lines must cross county lines as little as possible (N.C. Const. Art. II, §§ 3, 5; Stephenson v. Bartlett)
- Extreme partisan gerrymandering is also prohibited (*Common Cause v. Lewis*)
