


Redistricting Rules: Nebraska Timeline







Who draws the lines?

Congressional and state legislative lines are both drawn by the state legislature and subject to gubernatorial veto





What are the mapping rules?

- Federal equal population requirements and state constitution asks that legislative districts be "as nearly equal in population as may be" (Neb. Const. art. III, §5)
- Adherence to the Voting Rights Act and constitutional rules on race
- State legislative districts be contiguous and compact and keep county boundaries "whenever practicable" (Neb. Const. art. III, §5)
