


Redistricting Rules: S. Carolina Timeline



At least 5 months:

Public hearings to take communities of interest testimony

Approx. 4 months:

Process census data, display draft maps, hold hearings, complete maps

Court & County Prep

South Carolina does not have deadlines for its redistricting process, and there is ample time ahead of the candidate filing deadline.





Redistricting Rules: South Carolina Rules

Who draws the lines?

Congressional and state legislative lines are drawn by the state legislature as a statute and are subject to a gubernatorial veto





Redistricting Rules: South Carolina Rules

What are the mapping rules?

- ► Federal **equal population** requirements and adherence to the **Voting Rights Act** and constitutional rules on race
- ► In the past, the legislative redistricting committees have issued guidelines for drawing districts. The committees have yet to do so for the 2020 cycle.
